Issue of the 2011 collector set of Cyprus euro coins

The Central Bank of Cyprus announces the issue of a set of Cyprus euro coins in brilliant uncirculated condition and issue year 2011. This is the second set in the series of the Cyprus euro coin sets dedicated to the mosaics of Paphos which are included on UNESCO's World Heritage list. These mosaics decorated the floors of wealthy residences in the Roman period (58 BC – 330 AD).



The coins are set in a three - ply brochure placed in a sleeve. The brochure and sleeve present the ancient mosaic of the four seasons from the House of Dionysos.

The total number of sets issued is 10.000 and they will be sold in Cyprus and abroad.

Sales will start on 20 June 2011 and will continue while stocks last.

Sales to the public

The over the counter price has been set at €25,00 including VAT. Sales will be effected by the Central Bank of Cyprus over the counter in cash or through its e-shop at www.centralbank.gov.cy (payment with VISA or Mastercard). Sales will also be effected through other banks in Cyprus.

A discount of 10% on the sale price across the board, excluding VAT , will be offered to professional coin dealers for purchases of 100 sets and above.
